PRESS RELEASE 'MEGA CAMP' READY STEADY GO.....

Less than 24 hours to go to the launch of the 50 year celebrations for HSS UK and the atmosphere for the unique gathering of the 'Mega Camp' known as "Sanskriti Mahashibir" is electrifying.

As of today more than 500 volunteers from across Great Britain and Europe are finalising the preparations at Hertfordshire County Showground for the gathering that includes 2200 residents and 5000 people on the concluding ceremony. The final tally is expected to be a representation of over 90 towns and 15 countries

The uniqueness of the Sanskriti Mahashibir not only lies in the numbers and the purpose built tented towns but the quintessentially HSS UK philosophy embodied in the motto "Sanskar Sewa Sangathan" (loosely translated as Good values, Selfless working and Community spirit although this does not do justice to the spirit).

The site in Hertfordshire has seen over 400 tents built on 70 acres in less than a week and is already home to a purpose built exhibition and bookshop that would not be out of place at a prestigious museum. Couple that with onsite facilities for medical, catering, lecture sessions, yoga and physical activities that will culminate in grand closing ceremony on Sunday 31st July, one can see that this was mammoth task everyone has worked with a spirit and enthusiasm that truly embodies the camps motto and it hasn't even begun.

The resident participants will range from between 4 months old to 90 years old and the attention to detail right down to trying to make the provisions as environmentally friendly to providing a crèche and facilities that enable all participants to experience the strength and positive agenda which HSS UK has been promoting in the last 50 years and which it will continue to do.
