UK Parliament Week 2019 to be celebrated by HINDU SWAYAMSEVAK SANGH (U.K.)

From Sale in the North West to Bromley in the South, Southend in the East to Cheltenham in the West, over 24 branches will participate with a total of more than 720 participants. Debates, balloting, role playing, quizzes, Q & A with Members of Parliament, and Parliament education videos are some of the activities that will feature in our events. There may also be a few #UKPW themed Cup Cakes being featured!"

In 2018, UK Parliament Week reached almost 1 million people, with more than 8,100 activities. This year's UK Parliament Week festival is expected to be the largest ever.
