slough CPR training

In February, Dr Pushkarji Dadarkar took a session on how to do Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) during emergencies in which someone's breathing or heartbeat has stopped. Pushkarji explained various steps of CPR such as check for danger, call for help, check the victim's airway, rescue breaths, perform chest compressions, switch roles with the compressor and continue compressions until advanced medical help arrives.

Dr Pushkarji said 'I hope I demonstrated a systematic approach to resuscitation as well as utilising teamwork, discipline and communication - all skills we develop and done by coming to Shakha'

Shri. Dattopant Thengadi **The Visionary Pracharak**

On occasion of Ma. Dattopnatji's Birth Centenary 10th November

A bright young man walks into the office of a famous lawyer. The year is 1942, the place, Calicut (Kozhikode) Kerala.

He has a letter of

recommendation from another prominent lawyer from Chennai. The young man introduces himself, stating that he's come from Nagpur with the aim of spreading the message of Hindu Sanghathan in Kerala. The senior lawyer listens to this young man who also happens to be a law graduate.

In the end he says that the young man's task is futile because in Kerala, Hindu Dharma is already followed with devotion and con-viction, thus the idea of Hindu Sanghathan is superfluous. He then proceeds to advise the young man that he should not waste his life with this fruitless task but pursue his professional career.

He finishes up, suggesting that if there is a shortage of funds for the ticket back to Nagpur, he will contribute. But there is another gentleman, a doctor, sitting in the office who asks the young man to meet him later. The young man meets this doctor who helps him to start the first shakha in Kerala.

Seventy eight years later, Kerala now has the maximum number of shakhas in any State of India. This young man was none other than Shri. Dattopant Thengadi, whose birth centenary we are celebrating this year. He was a stalwart RSS Pracharak who inspired countless with his erudite oratory skills, vast knowledge and humble nature.



He is best known for starting Bharatiya Mazdoor Sangh (BMS) and against all odds, made it the largest trade union in India, while pounding the concept of the "Third Way".

Life journey of Dattopant Thengadi ji: Shri. Dattopant Thengadi (Dattatreya Bapurao Thengadi) was born in the village of Arvi near Nagpur, Maharashtra, on Deepawali, 10 November 1920. His father was a practicing lawyer. Young Dattatreya was a voracious reader and by the time he finished his schooling, he had read all the 10,000 books in his local Library.
